



Gilbertstone Primary School Year 6 Autumn 1 Newsletter



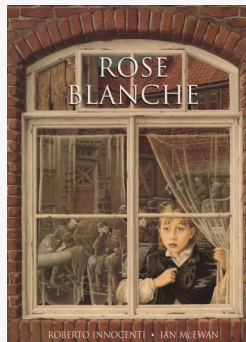
Hello and welcome to Year 6!



It has been lovely getting to know all of the children and we have been very impressed with how well they have started this new year. As there are three teachers across year 6, for their morning lessons, children are split into three groups to best support them. We are very pleased to say that the children have started the year with a super attitude to learning and we have already seen some amazing work!

Literacy

This half term, the children will be reading 'Rose Blanche'. This book is set during WW2 so links nicely to the children's History topic. Across this unit, the children will be learning various grammar skills: colons, semi-colons for lists, informal language and dashes. We look forward to reading their diary entries and speeches!



Reading

This half term, the children will be focussing on developing their retrieval skills as well as exploring vocabulary in context. We will be exploring some exciting fiction books including Kensuke's Kingdom, Goldfish Boy and The Girl of Ink and Stars.

Maths

In Maths this half term, we are going to be exploring place value, the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and fractions. In order to access all the learning in year 6, it is crucial that children can confidently recall all their times tables up to 12x12. If your child is not yet confident, you can support them with daily practise at home and encourage them to use TT Rockstars.

Science

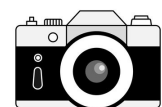
In Science this half term, we are learning how to classify living things, developing knowledge of vertebrates, invertebrates, plants and micro-organisms. The children have already produced some fantastic posters about cold-blooded vertebrates.



Wider Curriculum



This half term we will have a focus on History and Art. In History, we will use a range of sources to learn about the causes of WW2, The Blitz and evacuation.



In Art, our topic is macro photography where we are using cameras and learning how to manipulate images by editing photos.

Display boards

Over the last couple of weeks, Year 6 have been working hard to create two fantastic displays. In the corridor, they have produced some fantastic art and written work linked to 'The Lion and the Unicorn'.

They have also explored growth mindsets and positive affirmations. It has been lovely to see the motivational and positive quotes they have produced using the inspiration of 'Change your words, change your mindset'.



PE

Year 6 children will have indoor PE on a **Monday** where they will be developing their core strength and learning a variety of yoga poses. Outdoor PE will be on a **Friday** where children will be practising their throwing and catching and further developing their batting and fielding skills during rounders.
