



# Gilbertstone Primary School Year 4 Summer 2 Newsletter

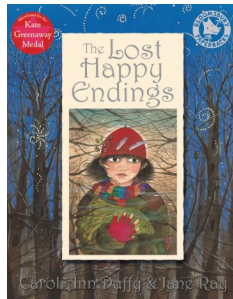


## Hello and welcome to Summer 2!

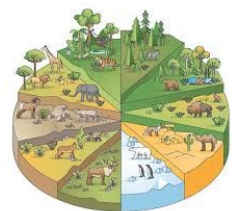


### Maths

In Maths this half term we are going to be learning about time, shape and statistics. Lots of children now know their times tables up to 12x12. Thank you for continuing to support them! Our Multiplication Tables Check is the first week back! Please continue to encourage your child to practise

### Science

In Science this half term, we will be learning about classification and changing habitats. Children will be learning to group living things and use classification keys.



### Wider Curriculum

This half term we will have a focus on DT and Geography. In Geography, we will be learning about rivers and the water cycle. Children will learn how rivers are formed and how they are used. In DT, we will be learning about pavilions. Children will explore a range of building techniques and materials before creating their own pavilions.
